RESOLUTION

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF THE ROBERTS AVENUE AND
LINCOLN AVENUE BEACH STREET END IMPROVEMENTS & FY2024 NJDCA
SMALL CITIES PROGRAM - ADA ACCESSIBILITY CONTRACT TO THINK
PAVERS HARDSCAPING, LLC**

WHEREAS, the City of Wildwood (the “City”), in accordance with the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law (“LCPL”), advertised for bids for construction services associated with the Roberts Avenue and Lincoln Avenue Street End Improvements & FY2024 NJDCA Small Cities Program – ADA Accessibility project (hereinafter the “Project”) pursuant to Resolution 88-2-26; and

WHEREAS, the City received two (2) bids in connection with the advertisement of the Project from Fred M. Schiavone Construction, Inc. and Think Pavers Hardscaping, LLC when bids were opened on March 5, 2026 pursuant to the LCPL; and

WHEREAS, said bids have been reviewed by the City and the City Engineer has issued its recommendation, attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein, that Think Pavers Hardscaping, LLC be awarded the contract as the **lowest responsible bidder** in the amount of One Million Eight Thousand One Hundred Twenty (\$1,008,120.00) Dollars; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer of the City of Wildwood has certified the availability of funds; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to award the Project to Think Pavers Hardscaping, LLC as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Wildwood, County of Cape May, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. That the provisions of the above preamble of this Resolution are hereby incorporated herein, by this reference, as if set forth at length.
2. That a contract for the Roberts Avenue and Lincoln Avenue Street End Improvements & FY2024 NJDCA Small Cities Program – ADA Accessibility project is hereby awarded to Think Pavers Hardscaping, LLC, 125 Kings Highway, Mount Royal, New Jersey 08061 in an amount of One Million Eight Thousand One Hundred Twenty (\$1,008,120.00) Dollars.
3. That a Notice of Award shall be published as required by law within ten (10) days of passage of this Resolution, which notice shall state that this Resolution and the contract are on file and available for public inspection in the office of the City Clerk.
4. That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute the contract on behalf of the City, and to take all other actions necessary to effectuate the purpose thereof.
