**RESOLUTION**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF AN EMERGENCY  
CONTRACT TO MCSHAFFRY MASONRY INC.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Wildwood (the “City”) experienced a failure and/or interruption in electrical service and a fire affecting City Hall and certain municipal operations, thereby creating a condition that jeopardizes the ability of the City to safely provide essential municipal services; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 6, 2026, the City Engineer provided correspondence to the City regarding the damage and opined that the same resulted in potential harm to the safety and health of the personnel and public utilizing City Hall and needed to be addressed on an emergent basis; and

**WHEREAS**, the City discovered the need for the excavation and removal of existing concrete slabs necessary to access and assess the electrical service infrastructure at City Hall; and

**WHEREAS**, the Local Public Contracts Law permits the award of an emergency contract pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6, without public advertising for bids, when an emergency affecting the public health, safety or welfare requires the immediate delivery of goods or the performance of services; and

**WHEREAS**, the emergent condition and need for the emergency work was communicated to the City’s Purchasing Agent, Chief Financial Officer, and Business Administrator, who confirmed the emergent nature of the condition and the necessity of awarding the contract immediately; and

**WHEREAS**, McShaffry Masonry Inc. competently provided the excavation services necessary for the City to address the emergent situation occasioned by the power failure.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Wildwood, County of Cape May, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. That the provisions of the above preamble of this Resolution are hereby incorporated herein, by this reference, as if set forth at length.
2. That the City hereby ratifies and approves the award of an emergency contract to McShaffry Masonry Inc., 967 Tecumseh Road, Cape May, NJ 08204 in the amount of Twelve Thousand One Hundred (\$12,100.00) Dollars, as more specifically set forth in the subject invoice, attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein.
3. That the Mayor, City Clerk, Chief Financial Officer, and all other appropriate City officials are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all actions necessary to effectuate the purpose of this Resolution, including the processing of payment for the emergency work performed.
