**RESOLUTION**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE WILDWOOD BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT (WBID) FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A CATALYST PROJECT: WAYFINDING & PUBLIC SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS IN CONJUNCTION WITH WILDWOOD'S NEIGHBORHOOD PRESERVATION PROGRAM FOR 2026**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Wildwood (the "City") has been admitted into the Neighborhood Preservation Program (NPP), which is offered by the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs (NJCA); and

**WHEREAS**, the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs has approved Wildwood's FY2026 Implementation Plan for the Pacific Avenue NPP District; and

**WHEREAS**, one of the approved activities in the 2026 Pacific Avenue NPP District Implementation Plan is a Catalyst Project that will implement a number of wayfinding and public safety improvements within the Pacific Avenue NPP District to support current activity, pedestrian engagement, and economic vitality, as more fully detailed in the FY2026 Implementation Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the WBID has agreed to supplement the funds available for the implementation of the improvements on Pacific Avenue, including in the NPP District; and

**WHEREAS**, the WBID will be the lead agency that contracts with professional contractors and vendors in order to facilitate the proposed wayfinding and public safety improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties have agreed to commit a total of \$321,000.00 to fund the improvements, with the Neighborhood Preservation Program contributing \$41,000.00 and the WBID contributing \$280,000.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer has certified in writing the availability of funds for the purposes set forth in this Resolution, a copy of which shall be on file with the City Clerk's Office.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Wildwood, County of Cape May, State of New Jersey, that:

1. The City of Wildwood will contribute \$41,000.00 from the FY2026 Neighborhood Preservation Program budget to the WBID towards the cost of implementing wayfinding and public safety improvements on Pacific Avenue and in the NPP District, as per the FY2026 Implementation Plan, hereto attached as **Exhibit A**.
2. The Mayor, Clerk, and Chief Financial Officer are hereby authorized to execute any agreement connected with this funding and any other documents necessary in connection therewith on behalf of the City of Wildwood, and the City Administrator and other City officials are also authorized and directed to take any and all other actions necessary to effectuate the purposes thereof.
