**AMENDING RESOLUTION #96-2-26 APPROVING THE INSTALLATION OF AERIAL
FIBER AND STRAND TO PUBLIC WORKS, WATER UTILITY AND SEWER
UTILITY TO INCREASE TO INCLUDE RECREATION CENTER**

WHEREAS, by the way of Res#96-2-26 approved February 25, 2026 the City of Wildwood approved the installation of aerial fiber and strand to Public Works, Water and Sewer Utility in the amount of One Hundred Thousand dollars (\$100,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the City has determined the need to include the Recreation Center located at 401 W. Youngs Avenue, Wildwood NJ 08260 and seeks to amend to increase the contract in the amount of Forty-Five Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-Four dollars (\$45,584.00) for a new contract total of One Hundred Forty-Five Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-Four dollars (\$145,584.00); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2b.(3)* (as amended by *P.L. 2011, c.139*) and LFN 2012-10, a New Jersey municipality may purchase goods and services without public bidding under the Local Public Contracts Law through the use of a nationally-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing contract that has been developed utilizing a competitive bidding or contracting process by another contracting unit within New Jersey or another state; and

WHEREAS, the subject cooperative purchasing contract was awarded by Omnia to Tel-Dat Communications utilizing a competitive contracting process; and

WHEREAS, also pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2b.(3)* (as amended by *P.L. 2011, c.139*) and LFN 2012-10, prior to making purchases under nationally-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing contracts, the municipality must determine that the use of the cooperative purchasing contract shall result in cost savings after all factors, including charges for service, material, and delivery, have been considered; and

WHEREAS, the Department has determined that the use of the Omnia Contract#02-139 purchasing contract to purchase the aforementioned equipment will result in cost savings to the City; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available for this purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Wildwood, County of Cape May, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby incorporated as if fully restated.
2. A contract for the install aerial fiber and strand to Public Works, Water Utility and Sewer Utility and Recreation Center for the sum of One Hundred Forty-Five Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-Four dollars (\$145,584.00) is hereby awarded to Tel-Dat Communications without public bidding as permitted by law.
3. If required, the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute an “End User Agreement” with Tel-Dat Communications pursuant to the terms of its nationally-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing agreement with the Omnia.
