RESOLUTION

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A DOG TREAT CONCESSION
TO SALTY PAWS CAPE MAY, NJ FOR THE 2026 SEASON**

WHEREAS, the City of Wildwood (the “City”) advertised for proposals in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq. for a concession license to sell dog treats and related products on the City beach adjacent to the Maple Avenue Dog Park at the April 22, 2026 Board of Commissioner’s Meeting; and

WHEREAS, the City received one (1) proposal when responses were opened on May 14, 2026, submitted by Salty Paws Cape May, NJ (“Salty Paws”), and evaluated the same as set forth in the specifications and proposal materials; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that the contract be awarded to Salty Paws as the sole responsible entity submitting the most advantageous proposal to the City in the amount of One Thousand Five Hundred (\$1,500.00) Dollars for the 2026 season; and

WHEREAS, the City and Salty Paws acknowledge that the City’s specifications and Salty Paws’ submission, incorporated by reference herein, shall govern the payment terms and rights and responsibilities of the parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Wildwood, County of Cape May, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. That the provisions of the above preamble of this Resolution are hereby incorporated herein, by this reference, as if set forth at length.
2. That a contract for a concession license to sell dog treats and related products on the City beach adjacent to the Maple Avenue Dog Park on the City beaches is hereby awarded to “Salty Paws Cape May, NJ” with an address of 2025 Chatham Drive, Bensalem, PA 19020 for the 2026 season for a total amount payable to the City of One Thousand Five Hundred (\$1,500.00) Dollars, to be paid in the manner and form as set forth in the specifications and proposal documents and subject to all of the terms therein.
3. That notice of this resolution and award shall be published as required by law.
4. That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute the contract on behalf of the City, and to take all other actions necessary to effectuate the purpose thereof.
