RESOLUTION

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH
THE MORRIS LAW FIRM LLC**

WHEREAS, on January 7, 2026, the City of Wildwood (the “City”) adopted Resolution No. 18-1-26, which authorized a professional services agreement with The Morris Law Firm LLC (“Morris”) to serve as City Solicitor for the 2026 calendar year; and

WHEREAS, on May 13, 2026, the City adopted a Resolution authorizing the appointment of Eric M. Bernstein, Esq. (“Bernstein”) to serve as Conflict Counsel on behalf of the City in matters where Morris is unavailable due to conflict or otherwise in an amount not to exceed Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) Dollars; and

WHEREAS, Morris has agreed to reduce the not to exceed amount identified in the Professional Services Agreement between the City and Morris by Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) Dollars to account for the work to be performed by Bernstein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Wildwood, in the County of Cape May, and the State of New Jersey, that the contract between the City of Wildwood and The Morris Law Firm LLC is hereby amended to reflect a decrease in the not to exceed amount by Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) Dollars for a new not to exceed amount of One Hundred Sixty Thousand (\$160,000.00) Dollars.
