RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT APPALACHIA HYDROGEOLOGIC & ENVIRONMENTAL CONSULTING, LLC IN CONNECTION WITH 2026 LANDFILL CLOSURE PROJECT ACTIVITIES

WHEREAS, the City of Wildwood (the “City”) is currently engaged in the closure of the former landfill and development of the former Department of Public Works site as part of the Bayside Redevelopment Area Project (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, Appalachia Hydrogeologic & Environmental Consulting, LLC (“Appalachia”) has provided the City with a proposal for professional services associated with 2026 LCP activities, as more specifically set forth in the Proposal dated May 27, 2026 and incorporated by reference herein; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contract Law N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq. permits for the adoption of a resolution authorizing the award of a contract for professional services without competitive bids; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer of the City of Wildwood has certified the availability of funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Wildwood, County of Cape May, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. That the provisions of the above preamble of this Resolution are hereby incorporated by reference as if set forth at length.
2. That the Board of Commissioners hereby approves a professional services agreement with Appalachia Hydrogeologic & Environmental Consulting, LLC, 678 Route 202 - Unit 4, Bridgewater, NJ 08807 as more specifically set forth in Exhibit “A”, annexed hereto and incorporated by reference herein, in an amount not to exceed Six Hundred Seventeen Thousand Two Hundred Ten (\$617,210.00) Dollars.
3. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute the contract on behalf of the City, and to take any and all other actions necessary to effectuate the purposes thereof.
4. The Business Disclosure Entity Certification shall be placed on the file with this Resolution.
5. That this Resolution shall be published according to law.
