RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF CHANGE ORDER NO. 2 – FINAL WITH LEXA CONCRETE, LLC IN THE DECREASED AMOUNT OF \$85,644.70 IN CONNECTION WITH FY2024 NJDOT LOCAL TRANSPORTATION PROJECT FUND, RECONSTRUCTION OF NEW YORK AVENUE

WHEREAS, the City of Wildwood awarded a contract to Lexa Concrete, LLC, 11 Commerce Way, Hammonton, NJ 08037 (hereinafter “Contractor”) for construction services associated with FY2024 NJDOT Local Transportation Project Fund, Reconstruction of New York Avenue (hereinafter “Project”), the material provisions of which are incorporated by reference herein; and

WHEREAS, the Project Engineer for the City, DeBlasio & Associates, P.C., has recommended Change Order No. 2 - Final for the Project, incorporated by reference herein, to provide for the removal and replacement of existing sanitary sewer casting and electrical manhole casting, install topsoil and see in lieu of sodding and As-Built Quantity Adjustments as set forth in the Change Order No. 2 -Final; and

WHEREAS, Change Order No. 2 – Final reduces the City’s financial contribution to the project by \$85,644.70 for a final contract amount of \$841,726.30; and

WHEREAS, the revisions to the contract and this Change Order are necessary in order to complete the project in the most impactful, efficient and cost-effective manner for residents of the City of Wildwood; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer for the City of Wildwood has certified as to the availability of funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Wildwood, County of Cape May, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. That the provisions of the above preamble of this Resolution are hereby incorporated herein, by this reference, as if set forth at length.
2. That the Contractor’s contract is hereby modified and amended to reflect the substantive portions of Change Order No. 2 – Final and to include a decrease in the amount of \$85,644.70, for a revised final contract total of \$841,726.30.
3. That all appropriate municipal officials of the City of Wildwood are hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to undertake the necessary actions to further the execution of said Change Order No. 2 - Final.
4. That notice of this Resolution shall be published according to law.
