RESOLUTION

**RESOLUTION APPROVING GLENWOOD AVENUE BOARDWALK BATHROOM
ROOF REPLACEMENT AND WILDWOOD MUNICIPAL COURT BUILDING ROOF
REPAIRS**

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works (“Department”) recommends the City of Wildwood (the “City”) Replace the Glenwood Ave Bathroom Roof due to the existing roofing material has peeled off causing many leaks. Repairs to the Municipal Court Building Roof due to tears that were patched but still leaking; and

WHEREAS, the Department has researched vendors and determined that the sought-after equipment may be procured through a state-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing contract between Bergen County Co-Op Roof Repairs, Replacement and Maintenance Bid #BC-23-46 under the Master Service Contract #CK04-Bergen and #11BeCCP, Resolution Number 1408-23 and Pravco Incorporated; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2b.(3)* (as amended by *P.L. 2011, c.139*) and LFN 2012-10, a New Jersey municipality may purchase goods and services without public bidding under the Local Public Contracts Law through the use of a state-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing contract that has been developed utilizing a competitive bidding or contracting process by another contracting unit within New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the subject cooperative purchasing contract was awarded by Bergen County Co-Op Roof Repairs, Replacement and Maintenance Bid #BC-23-46 under the Master Service Contract #CK04-Bergen and #11BeCCP, Resolution Number 1408-23 and Pravco Incorporated utilizing a competitive contracting process; and

WHEREAS, also pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2b.(3)* (as amended by *P.L. 2011, c.139*) and LFN 2012-10, prior to making purchases under state-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing contracts, the municipality must determine that the use of the cooperative purchasing contract shall result in cost savings after all factors, including charges for service, material, and delivery, have been considered; and

WHEREAS, the Department has determined that the use of the Bergen County Co-Op Roof Repairs, Replacement and Maintenance Bid #BC-23-46 under the Master Service Contract #CK04-Bergen and #11BeCCP, Resolution Number 1408-23 cooperative purchasing contract to replace and repair roofs the aforementioned equipment will result in cost savings to the City; and

WHEREAS, consistent with the Bergen County cooperative purchasing contract and needs of the City, Pravco Incorporated has submitted a proposal to Replace the Glenwood Ave Boardwalk Bathroom Roof and Repair the Municipal Court Building Roof for the sum of Fifty-Three Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$53,200.00); and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available for this purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Wildwood, County of Cape May, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby incorporated as if fully restated.
2. A contract to Replace the Glenwood Ave Boardwalk Bathroom Roof and Repair the Municipal Court Building Roof for the sum of Fifty-Three Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$53,200.00) is hereby awarded to Pravco Incorporated without public bidding as permitted by law.
3. If required, the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute an “End User Agreement” with Pravco Incorporated pursuant to the terms of its state-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing agreement with the Bergen County Co-Op Roof Repairs, Replacement and Maintenance Bid #BC-23-46 under the Master Service Contract #CK04-Bergen and #11BeCCP, Resolution Number 1408-23
