RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF A 2027 FORD F-450 WITH AN ALUMINUM DUMP BODY AND A BUYER'S SALT DOGG UNDER TAILGATE SPREADER.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works (“Department”) recommends the City of Wildwood (the “City”) purchase a 2027 Ford F-450 with an Aluminum Dump Body and a Buyers Salt Dogg Under Tailgate Spreader; and

WHEREAS, the Department has researched vendors and determined that the sought-after equipment may be procured through a state-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing contract between Bergen County Co-Op 24-06 and All American Ford of Paramus; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2b.(3)* (as amended by *P.L. 2011, c.139*) and LFN 2012-10, a New Jersey municipality may purchase goods and services without public bidding under the Local Public Contracts Law through the use of a state-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing contract that has been developed utilizing a competitive bidding or contracting process by another contracting unit within New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the subject cooperative purchasing contract was awarded by Bergen County Co-Op 24-06 to All American Ford of Paramus utilizing a competitive contracting process; and

WHEREAS, also pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2b.(3)* (as amended by *P.L. 2011, c.139*) and LFN 2012-10, prior to making purchases under state-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing contracts, the municipality must determine that the use of the cooperative purchasing contract shall result in cost savings after all factors, including charges for service, material, and delivery, have been considered; and

WHEREAS, the Department has determined that the use of the Bergen County Co-Op 24-06 cooperative purchasing contract to purchase the aforementioned equipment will result in cost savings to the City; and

WHEREAS, consistent with the Bergen County cooperative purchasing contract and needs of the City, All American Ford of Paramus has submitted a proposal to provide for the City a 2027 Ford F-450 with an Aluminum Dump Body and a Buyers Salt Dogg Under Tailgate Spreader for the sum of Ninety-Three Thousand Three Hundred and Sixty-Six Dollars and Sixty Cents (\$93,366.60); and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available for this purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Wildwood, County of Cape May, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby incorporated as if fully restated.
2. A contract for the purchase of a 2027 Ford F-450 with an Aluminum Dump Body and a Buyers Salt Dogg Under Tailgate Spreader for the sum of Ninety-Three Thousand Three Hundred and Sixty-Six Dollars and Sixty Cents (\$93,366.60) is hereby awarded to All American Ford of Paramus without public bidding as permitted by law.
3. If required, the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute an “End User Agreement” with All American Ford of Paramus pursuant to the terms of its state-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing agreement with the Bergen County Co-Op 24-06.
