RESOLUTION

**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF CUMARU DECKING FOR THE
WILDWOOD BOARDWALK REHABILITATION PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the City of Wildwood (the “City”) is in need of procuring Cumaru Decking for the Wildwood Boardwalk Rehabilitation Project; and

WHEREAS, the City has researched vendors and determined that the sought-after product may be procured through a nationally-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing contract between OMNIA Partners and 84 Lumber Company; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2b. (3)* (as amended by *P.L. 2011, c.139*) and LFN 2012-10, a New Jersey municipality may purchase goods and services without public bidding under the Local Public Contracts Law through the use of a nationally-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing contract that has been developed utilizing a competitive bidding or contracting process by another contracting unit within New Jersey or another state; and

WHEREAS, OMNIA Partners is a cooperative purchasing organization for public sector procurement; and

WHEREAS, the subject cooperative purchasing contract was awarded by OMNIA Partners to 84 Lumber utilizing a competitive contracting process; and

WHEREAS, also pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2b.(3)* (as amended by *P.L. 2011, c.139*) and LFN 2012-10, prior to making purchases under nationally-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing contracts, the municipality must determine that the use of the cooperative purchasing contract shall result in cost savings after all factors, including charges for service, material and delivery, have been considered; and

WHEREAS, the Department has determined that the City’s use of the OMNIA Partners cooperative purchasing contract to procure the aforementioned products will result in cost savings to the City; and

WHEREAS, consistent with the OMNIA Partners cooperative purchasing contract and needs of the City, 84 Lumber has submitted estimate #1504 incorporated by reference herein to supply the City with Cumaru Decking for the sum of Four Hundred Sixty Thousand Four Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$460,480.00); and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available for this purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Wildwood, County of Cape May, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby incorporated as if fully restated.
2. A contract for the purchase of Cumaru Decking for the City for the sum of Four Hundred Sixty Thousand Four Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$460,480.00); is awarded to 84 Lumber without public bidding as permitted by law.
3. If required, the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute an “Construction Development Services Material Agreement” with 84 Lumber pursuant to the terms of its nationally-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing agreement with the OMNIA Partners.
