**RESOLUTION**

**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF A 2026 FORD TRANSPORT VAN FOR  
THE WILDWOOD POLICE DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Wildwood Police Department (“Department”) recommends the City of Wildwood (the “City”) purchase a 2026 Ford Transport Van; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department has researched vendors and determined that the sought-after equipment may be procured through a state-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing contract between Bergen County Cooperative Contract #BC-BID-24-43 and Winner Ford; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2b.(3)* (as amended by *P.L. 2011, c.139*) and LFN 2012-10, a New Jersey municipality may purchase goods and services without public bidding under the Local Public Contracts Law through the use of a nationally-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing contract that has been developed utilizing a competitive bidding or contracting process by another contracting unit within New Jersey or another state; and

**WHEREAS**, the subject cooperative purchasing contract was awarded by Bergen County Cooperative to Winner Ford utilizing a competitive contracting process; and

**WHEREAS**, also pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2b.(3)* (as amended by *P.L. 2011, c.139*) and LFN 2012-10, prior to making purchases under nationally-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing contracts, the municipality must determine that the use of the cooperative purchasing contract shall result in cost savings after all factors, including charges for service, material, and delivery, have been considered; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department has determined that the use of the Bergen County Cooperative Contract #BC-BID-24-43 cooperative purchasing contract to purchase the aforementioned equipment will result in cost savings to the City; and

**WHEREAS**, consistent with the Bergen County Cooperative purchasing contract and needs of the City, Winner Ford has submitted a proposal to provide for the City a 2026 Ford Transport Van for the sum of \$51,982.50; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available for this purchase.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Wildwood, County of Cape May, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby incorporated as if fully restated.
2. A contract for the purchase of a 2026 Ford Transport Van for the sum of \$51,982.50 is hereby awarded to Winner Ford without public bidding as permitted by law.
3. If required, the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute an “End User Agreement” with Winner Ford pursuant to the terms of its state- recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing agreement with the Bergen County Cooperative Contract# BC-BID-24-43.
